MY RECENT PILIGRIMAGE TO ROME AND BEYOND

It is with joy in my heart that I share with you the beautiful experiences of my recent pilgrimage to Rome and beyond, where I and the other pilgrims walked in the footsteps of saints and deepened our faith together.

On September 29th, we gathered at London Gatwick, filled with excitement as we boarded our flight to Rome. That evening, we made our way to the Basilica of St. Peter in Chains for a private Mass. There, we were awed by Michelangelo's famous Statue of Moses. This is an unforgettable start to our pilgrimage.

The next day was filled with spiritual richness as we visited three great basilicas. The Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, and we walked through the Holy Door. Then we visited the Archbasilica of St. John Lateran, the cathedral church of Rome. Finally, the Basilica of St. Mary Major, Pope Francis' final resting place.

Wednesday was dedicated to the majestic St. Peter's Basilica. Before dawn, we set out to attend the Papal Audience, where I felt the collective faith of all those present. We also walked through the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica, a moment

that will stay with us forever. We explored the impressive crypt, visiting the tombs of St. Peter and recent Popes, feeling connected to our Church's rich history.





On our journey's last days, we travelled beyond Rome to Lanciano, the site of the first recorded Eucharistic Miracle. Here, we held our private Mass and reflected together on Christ's real presence in the Eucharist. Our pilgrimage took us to San Giovanni Rotondo, where we visited the shrine of St. Padre Pio, experiencing the powerful legacy of a saint who dedicated his life to love and service. Then we visited the sanctuary of St. Michael the Archangel and we saw St. Michael's cave and celebrated mass there with other pilgrims from different parts of the world.

We also paid homage to St. Rita in Cascia, a patroness of difficult cases, where many of us found inspiration in her story. We celebrated our private Mass here.

Our pilgrimage culminated in the beautiful town of Assisi, where St. Francis and St. Clare lived out their commitment to Christ. In the Basilica of St. Francis, we concelebrated Mass and the main celebrant was a Cardinal from Northern Ireland.

We also viewed St. Carlo Acutis' tomb here. Finally we visited the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels. It was here the young Francis of Assisi understood his vocation and founded the order of Friars Minor.

Actually this pilgrimage was not just about places; it was about deepening my faith and I am willing to share my experiences with you.

In the special way I would like to extend my sincere thanks to all of you for your prayers and generosity in the preparation of this wonderful and fruitful pilgrimage. I just want you to know that throughout this pilgrimage you were in my prayers and in my heart.
