We want to thank especially our volunteer team who analysed the data for their careful data analysis, and the Parish Mission Group (PMG) and Local Church Group (LCG) for their tireless effort in reaching this important milestone. Your hard work has made this consultation possible.

We're delighted to share this report with you promptly, so everyone has space to read, pray, and reflect on what it shows us. In the weeks ahead, we will continue discerning together and consult with the Diocese and the Bishop as we plan the way forward.

Please take some time over the next couple of weeks to read the report, share and discuss it in your local communities, and continue this spirit of listening and hope.

Diocesan Roadshows Report In February 2025, four Diocesan Roadshows gathered clergy and parish representatives for prayer, dialogue, and reflection on our shared future. Nearly 300 questions and comments were received and have now been carefully reviewed and addressed. The full report — outlining key themes and next steps towards a more missionary, outward-looking Church — is available on our parish website and in hard copy at the back of the church.
