The St Vincent de Paul Society was formed by Frederic Ozanam in the Sorbonne in Paris in 1833. The spark of compassion ignited by Frederic and a group of students was taken up by likeminded people across Europe and the first Conference meeting in England was held 180 years ago on February 12th 1844.
