Dear Friends,

I write this note to 'Thank you' for your understanding and cooperation at this time of difficult change within our Parish of The Annunciation. I know for some people not having Holy Mass in your respective churches each week has been painful. For some going to other churches has not been easy and more so for those, unable to get to Holy Mass. This is a challenging time for everyone and inevitably there will be more challenging times ahead. I ask you for your continued support.

Michael, our seminarian student, said, "While we are blessed to have Lucas and I studying for the Priesthood, I am in my 4th year and Lucas in his 2nd year, and by the time we are Ordained to the Priesthood things are going to change even more so for the churches within our diocese".

My friends, you and I need to be proactive in supporting each other. I need to ensure that both Fr Evarist and I keep well, so that we can take care of you and administer the sacraments to you, and you need to look after each other by ensuring where possible you can offer each other lifts, if there is no Holy Mass in your church.

As we are a very big parish, trying to ensure that there are six weekend Masses (one in church), is a challenge This may mean that we must go where the Holy Mass is actually being celebrated. This is tough for all of us. I hope and pray we will get back to normal upon Fr Evarist's return from his holiday. For the time being we each need to be prepared to step out of our comfort zone and go beyond the boundaries of what we know to embrace what the Lord wants us to encounter and experience. The Joy of His Gospel in another place.

There is no easy solution. It is getting harder to get supply priests, as many of our retired priests who were able to help us in the past are facing changes to their own health needs and are not able to travel around in the way they once did. In four months, last year we spent over £7,000 on supply priests. We can't put a price on the Sacrifice of Holy Mass, we as a Parish Mission Team and Local Church Teams need to work together to ensure that we can support each other through these challenging times.

Friends, can we please be positive and proactive in working together to take care of each other? Let us be an anchor of HOPE and a beacon of LIGHT, so that we can stand together, hand in hand with hearts filled with faith in the one (Jesus) who binds us together.
