Open your Heart And Heal your Soul

Dear Friends,

Following on form my homily last week, I want to encourage you to continue your journey through Advent. These final days of preparation for the coming of Christ anew into our hearts are fast disappearing. On this, the third Sunday of Advent or Gaudete Sunday, we sense a definite mood change. The austerity of what can be a sombre, though hope-filled penitential season, is replaced by a shift of emphasis. We see a burst of colour appearing at the Mass today as rose-coloured vestments replace the violet and we are enjoined at the Introit to: Rejoice in the Lord and again I say rejoice or Gaudete in Domino semper, hence Gaudete Sunday. But why this shift in emphasis? We are edging that bit nearer to celebrating the coming of Our Lord at Christmas, that is undeniably true, but also because St John the Baptist is proclaiming the Coming of our Saviour. As we approach the 3rd Sunday of Advent, let us press the pause button!

Joy comes from knowing that we are redeemed. As the first reading reminds us, it is the joy of knowing that God has removed the judgment hanging over our heads; it is the joy of knowing that our Lord, our Mighty Saviour is in our midst and that "He will exult with joy over you, he will renew you by his love; he will dance with shouts of joy for you as on a day of festival." That joy is not found under the Christmas tree. That joy is not found in all the new expensive toys and gadgets and branded clothing we thirst for. That joy is not found in a new job with better pay and prospects. That joy is not in someone that you've just met, even though you're married. That joy is found only at the foot of the cross. Only when we come to recognise the love of God as displayed on the cross - the Son of God who has died for our sins, only then can we experience joy, lasting joy, real joy, the joy of a forgiven sinner, one who has been redeemed from sin and death. The joy of knowing that my salvation has been won by Christ on the cross and that He will return to complete what He has already begun. If our lack of joy is a consequence of our separation from God, then the reason for our joy is being reunited with Him.
