Suffering touches all our lives—through illness, loss, or mental distress—but as Christians, we face it with compassion and enduring hope, trusting that Christ walks with us.

A joint initiative of the Bishops' Conferences of England and Wales, Scotland, and Ireland, Day for Life promotes the protection and dignity of life at every stage.

#### Second Collection - 14th/15th June

There will be a Second Collection at all Masses this weekend to support Day for Life's pastoral work, education, and life-affirming initiatives.

Let us be a people of hope, standing with those who suffer and cherishing the gift of life.

The Pilgrimage of Hope is a national walking pilgrimage for England and Wales with four Ways converging at the Saint Barnabas Cathedral, Nottingham, on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> September; it is an initiative of the Hearts in Search of God project. The Ways start at the Catholic cathedrals in Cardiff, Leeds, Norwich and Westminster and will bless our nations with a Sign of the Cross. A small group of perpetual pilgrims will walk the full distance of each Way, with up to 20 day pilgrims joining for day stages. 


### **Raffle Sales to Support Our Young Pilgrims**

## CALLING ALL PARENTS AND PARISHIONERS

Pope Leo XIV held the first Ordinary Public Consistory of his pontificate on Friday morning, with Cardinals giving their formal approval for the canonizations.

During the ceremony, the Holy Father announced that Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati and Blessed Carlo Acutis will be canonized together on **7 September.** 

The canonizations of the two young saints—one from the early twentieth century, the other the first twenty-first-century saint—have been greatly anticipated due to the great devotion among the faithful.

Fr Neil and I along with our Youth Service intend to take another group of young people from our Parish and across the Diocese to Rome and Assisi, for the Canonisation of Blessed Carlo Acutis.
