### "ARE YOU NOT UNDER MY SHADOW AND PROTECTION"

Greetings from The Basilica of Our Lady of Guadeloupe, in Mexico. We have 16 people from our diocese on the pilgrimage, there are 44 pilgrims in total! I have remembered you and all your loved one's in our Mass this morning.

The message of Our Lady of Guadeloupe, is so simple, and yet if we are not careful we can complicate it. Her words to Juan Diego, were,

"Am I not here, I who am your Mother? Are you not under my shadow and protection?

Am I not the source of your joy? Are you not in the hollow of my mantel, in the

crossing of my arm's? Do you need anything more?"

Let us hear Our Blessed Lady's, words anew in our own hearts. The Power of her words must fill us with a renewed hope, and love for her and her Son Jesus. When Our Blessed Lady, said, "Are you not under my shadow and protection" What did she mean? Do you feel the power of her shadow and protection? Every day we live under the shadow and protection of Our Blessed Mother, but do we both know and believe it?





The power of Our Blessed Lady's shadow and protection, has certainly manifested its self during this pilgrimage. The words she spoke to Juan Diego, are the same words she is speaking to me, John Martin, Parish Priest! And I know Our Blessed Lady is speaking the same words to you! Allow the power and grace of your own holiness to help you see and believe, that, these very same words are directed to you reading them. Be bold believe and trust in them. They will bring you great comfort, in times of need, solace and struggles of life. Our Lady of Guadalupe, is reaching out to you, open your heart to her, she so much wants to comfort you and bring you peace and all you need in this life and as always she will point you to her Son, our Redeemer! Our Lady made four apparitions to Juan Diego and one to his uncle between December 9th and December 12, 1531. After all these years Our Lady's powerful

presence is still felt today with some twenty million pilgrims visiting her sanctuary each year with around nine million on her Feast Day 12 December.

I know you don't, but if you do need some proof here is some scientific facts for you to ponder in prayer:

- There is scientific proof that the material of the cloth the image is on should have disintegrated a few centuries ago.
- There is scientific proof that the colours of the image are not comprised of paint dyes normally used at that time.
- There is scientific proof that the eyes of your image, reflect, under microscopic vision, the room where you first appeared to the local Bishop.

School admissions to Catholic Secondary Academies (Year 7) - Children born between 01/09/2013 and 31/08/2014. The deadline for submitting your application for a school place is 31<sup>st</sup> October 2024. Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion you should also complete a supplementary information form, and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You MUST also include the supporting evidence as required with this form, eg baptism certificate (photocopies acceptable; if you do not have the evidence contact the parish where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time). Failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place.
